Board Term of up to four (4) Years

Msinsi Holdings (SOC) Ltd, trading as Msinsi Resorts and Game Reserves ("Msinsi"), is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Umgeni Water mandated primarily to manage water resources around Umgeni Water managed / owned dams. Msinsi is one of the most successful organisations involved in water resource management with five beautiful reserves situated around some of the largest and most picturesque dams in KZN.

Individuals and organisations are invited to submit nominations of suitably qualified persons to be considered for appointment as members of the Board of Msinsi.

The Board must comprise of interested, suitably qualified persons to be considered for appointment as independent non-executive directors for Msinsi with the following combination of skills and experience that would best increase Board effectiveness.

- a) Contract Management; Corporate and Project Finance; Water Resource Specialists; Treasury; Legal, Governance and Risk Management; Human Resource Management; Accountant and Environmental Management; Labour and or representing Stakeholders.
- b) Experience in the Water, tourism and nature reserves sector will be an added advantage.

- c) Must have personal attributes of objectivity, integrity, good reputation, commitment and should be a South African citizen.

- d) Appropriate knowledge of, understanding and experience in exercising fiduciary duties in accordance with the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act 1 of 1999 and Water Services Act of 107 of 1997, King Code of Good Corporate Governance (King IV) and the Companies Act 71 of 2008, and other relevant prescripts.

Grounds of Disqualification: A nominee will not be considered to hold office as a member of the Board if he/she is an un-rehabilitated insolvent, has been convicted of any offence involving dishonesty, fraud or has been sentenced to imprisonment without the option of a fine.

Requirements: Upon appointment, the Board of Umgeni Water reserves the right to conduct probity checks (criminal and civil records; reference checks; verification of qualifications and experience; credit record and integrity test). Every nomination of a person for appointment to the Board must be signed by a proposer and seconded, none of whom may be the nominee, and must also contain the nominee's signed acceptance. No person may nominate or second more than one candidate.

Stipends: The appointed Board members shall receive a stipend as determined and approved by the Minister of Human Settlement, Water and Sanitation. The stipend is paid in respect of expenses incurred in, and during, attendance of official duties.

Please note: All Board meetings and Board sub-committee meetings will be scheduled to take place during normal business hours and nominees will be expected to make themselves available to attend.
