### Tender Title: RAW WATER AUGMENTATION TO THE HARDING SUPPLY SYSTEM FROM THE WEZA RIVER – EMERGENCY SCHEME

#### T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

Umgeni Water is a state owned business enterprise that operates within the South African legislative parameters. The primary function of Umgeni Water is to supply treated water in bulk to its municipal customers.

Competent and experienced Contractors with A CIDB grading of 7CE or higher is required are invited to Tender for the following:

Raw Water Augmentation to the Harding Supply System from The Weza River – Emergency Scheme.

In addition to the Eligibility Criteria specified in Clause F2.1 of the tender document, tenderers are required to fulfil the following: The Tenderer's design engineer must be registered with the Engineering Council of South Africa as a Pr Eng or PrTech.

Tenderers are required to achieve a stipulated minimum threshold of seventy (70) percent for locally produced valves and actuators, ninety (90) percent for locally produced electrical cables and one hundred (100) percent for steel pipe fittings and specials, as designated by the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for Local Production and Content.

Industry/sector/sub-sector	Minimum threshold for local content
Electrical and telecom cables	90%
Valves & actuators	70%
Steel Pipe Fittings and Specials (Bare)	100%

Tenderers are required to achieve at least 35% Contract Participation Goals (CPG) including a minimum 5% Black Women Participation of the value of goods, services and works paid to one or more Enterprises (CPG Partner/s) as agreed with Umgeni Water before contract award. Tenderers who are the main contractor (irrespective of BBEE classification) are not exempt from this requirement and are still required to have a CPG Partner.

Evaluation method:

The tender will firstly be evaluated on eligibility. If found to be eligible, it will be further evaluated in two stages i.e.

- Functionality shall be assessed. A minimum functionality score of seventy (70) points is required for the tender to be considered further.
- Price & Preference using the 80/20 or 90/10 Preference Point Scoring System in terms of PPPFA
