### T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

Umgeni Water is a state owned business enterprise and it operates within the South African legislative parameters of the Water Services Act 108 of 1997, Public Finance Management Act 1 of 1999 and Public Audit Act 25 of 2004.

Competent and experienced service providers are invited to tender for the following:

Midmar Water Works AS-I Network For Old Filters and Pulsators

In addition to the Eligibility Criteria specified in Clause F2.1 of the tender document, tenderers are required to fulfil the following:

Tenderers are required to achieve a stipulated minimum threshold of seventy (70) percent for locally produced valves and actuators, and ninety (90) percent for locally produced electrical cables as designated by the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for Local Production and Content.

| Industry/sector/sub-sector    | Minimum threshold for local content |
|-------------------------------|-------------------------------------|
| Electrical and telecom cables | 90%                                 |
| Valves & actuators            | 70%                                 |

Tenderers are required to achieve at least 35% Contract Participation Goals (CPG) including a minimum 5% Black Women Participation of the value of goods, services and works paid to one or more targeted enterprises to comply with Umgeni Water's BBBEE policy initiative.

CIDB grading of 6 EB/EP or higher is required

#### Evaluation method:

The tender will firstly be evaluated on eligibility. If found to be eligible, it will be further evaluated in two stages i.e.

- Functionality shall be assessed. A minimum functionality score of 70 points is required for the tender to be considered further.
- Price & Preference using the 80/20 Preference Point Scoring System in terms of PPPFA
