T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

Umgeni Water is a state owned business enterprise that operates within the South African legislative parameters. The primary function of Umgeni Water is to supply treated water in bulk to its municipal customers.

Competent and experienced Contractors are invited to Tender for the following:

The civil, mechanical and electrical infrastructure required for abstracting, de-silting and pumping raw water from the Umkhomazi River to a high level reservoir system. The works include a 10m high temporary coffer dam and other river diversion measures; a 66m long approx. 3.5m high crump weir; a 20m high abstraction works including low lift pumping station (4 by 500kW, 6.6kV pumpsets), a 20m high and 40m wide mass-gravity access platform with a guardhouse and 6MVA standby generator installation and underground fuel tank; a cluster of 9 hydrocyclones; a two-compartment RC balancing tank; a 52m x 21m x 14m high multi-level High Lift Pumpstation building (incorporating 5 No. 1.1MW, 6.6kV pumps, 3 No. 22kV/6.6kV transformers, 2 No. 6.6kV/0.4kV transformers, 9 No. MV VSDs / MCCs).

In addition to the Eligibility Criteria specified in Clause F2.1 of the tender document, tenderers are required to fulfil the following:

Tenderers are required to achieve a stipulated minimum threshold of seventy (70%) for locally produced valves and actuators, and ninety (90%) percent for locally produced electrical cables, eighty (80%) for Steel Pipes, eighty (80%) for Steel Pipe Fittings and Specials (Coated and Lined) and 70% for Pumps, Medium Voltage (MV) Motor and Associated Accessories as designated by the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for Local Production and Content.

A CIDB grading of 9CE or higher is required

Tenderers are required to achieve at least 35% Contract Participation Goals (CPG) including a minimum 10% Black Women and Local Participation of the value of goods, services and Works paid to one or more targeted enterprises to comply with Umgeni Water's BBBEE policy initiative.

Evaluation method:

The tender will firstly be evaluated on eligibility. If found to be eligible, it will be further evaluated in two stages i.e.

- Functionality shall be assessed. A minimum functionality score of seventy (70) points is required for the tender to be considered further.
- Price & Preference using the 90/10 Preference Point Scoring System in terms of PPPFA
