Tenderers are required to achieve at least 35% Contract Participation Goals (CPG) including a minimum of 10% Black Women Participation and 10% Local Participation of the value of goods, services and works paid to one or more Enterprises (CPG Partner/s) as agreed with Umgeni Water before contract award. Tenderers who are the main contractor (irrespective of BBBEE classification) are not exempt from this requirement and are still required to have a CPG Partner.
